White Cloud is located about an hour's drive north of Grand Rapids, nestled in Northern rural Newaygo County. With much of the community alongside the banks of the White River, White Cloud is home of many rich scenic views and family activities. White Cloud has a small town feel and strives on community togetherness. It has become recognized as a Trail Town and serves as the base for enjoying the North Country National Scenic Trail in Newaygo County and the lower Huron-Manistee Forest.

The district consists of one Elementary, one Junior High and one High School.

White Cloud Public Schools belong to the Newaygo Promise Zone providing high school graduates with a tuition-free path to an associate degree. The Promise Zone believes every student should have the opportunity to earn post-secondary credentials.

White Cloud Schools has consistently ranked in the top 100 schools in the state of Michigan and has been named "one of the Nation's best high schools" by U.S. News & World Report.

With recently receiving a \$9.8 million bond for technology and safety of its students, White Cloud Public Schools has cutting edge technology which allows its students to experience how life will be in college and beyond. With this bond the district was also able to install a new track around the football field, new instruments for the band, more elective classes for the junior high and high school students and expand the parking lot at the elementary in order to implement curbside pickup and drop off. Funds also came in to redo the gymnasium floor in the high school.

All schools in the district practice Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports (PBIS). This has transformed the school climate to be more trauma informed and understanding of outside influences on the students in the district.
