- ✓ Student develops work routine and completes assignments and goals from home or the lab with mentor support.

Student Requirements

- ✓ Student **must** attend orientation
- ✓ Student **must** complete weekly assignments
- ✓ Student **must** complete all required state testing PSAT, SAT, MSTEP
- ✓ Student **must** work on classes weekly
- ✓ Student **must** complete **ALL** tests in the learning lab

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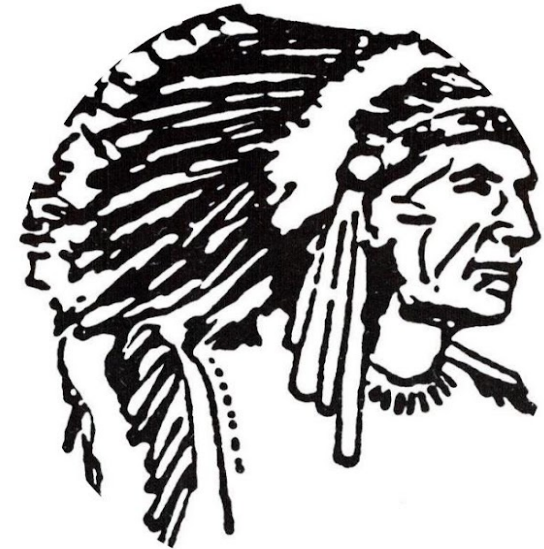
